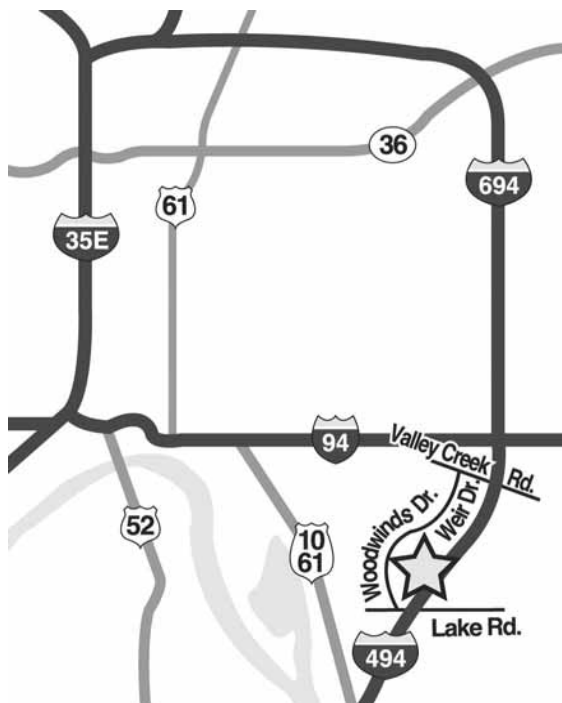

"Pulmonary Transfusion Reactions" Nancy Van Buren, MD

Pulmonary transfusion reactions are relatively common and often serious, yet sometimes overlooked as being related to transfusion. Reactions that affect the lungs include transfusion-associated circulatory overload, allergic reactions, bacterial contamination, hemolytic, embolism, and transfusion-related acute lung injury (TRALI). This talk will cover the causes of pulmonary transfusion reactions, laboratory evaluation, management, and actions undertaken by blood collecting facilities to reduce the incidence of TRALI.

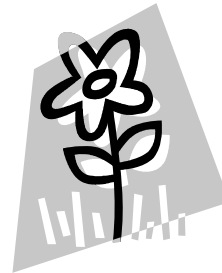
